SUBJECT: Installation Policy Memorandum #15-14, Environmental Policy

1. References:

a. Army Regulation 200-1, Environmental Protection and Enhancement, 13 Dec 07.

b. International Organization for Standardization (ISO) 14001:2004 (E), Environmental Management Systems (EMS).

2. Purpose: To communicate the goal of instilling an environmental ethic throughout the installation similar to the manner in which the responsibility for safety has become a part of everyday life.

3. Scope: This policy applies to all National Guard, Reserve and active duty Army component units, Garrison Directorates, Tenants, Residents and Contractors working either permanently or temporarily on Fort Greely.

4. Applicability: The mission of Fort Greely is to synchronize, integrate and deliver services and sustain facilities in support of the Senior Mission Commander, Missile Defense Agency and Tenants. We will perform this mission in concert with our stewardship responsibilities to protect, and conserve the environment by striving to attain an environmentally sustainable Fort Greely.

5. Policy: Fort Greely has established the E-RISK motto to identify the principal driver of an EMS which is to assess risk to the environment and the organization while clarifying the role that the EMS must take in order to be relevant.

6. In accomplishing our mission at Fort Greely, we commit to the following **E-RISK** motto:

a. **Environmental integration** into all aspects of the Fort Greely mission.

b. **Review activities** by weighing environmental impacts from activities at least annually to identify those with a significant risk and establish goals with action plans to reduce that risk.

c. **Implement measures** to reduce environmental risk with established processes to communicate, training, operate, control, prepare, allocate necessary resources needed to sustain the mission and prevent pollution.

d. **Show its working** through the installation Planning Board (IPB), Environmental Quality Control Committee (EQCC) and Energy Water Council (EWC) reviews, conformance and compliance audits and maintaining the installation corrective action plan (ICAP).

e. **Keep Improving** through programmatic reviews by senior leaders, complying with all applicable environmental laws, regulations, requirements and policies.

The E-RISK motto:

E = Environmental Integration.

R = Review activities.

I = Implement measures.


S = Show its working.
